Exploring food as a source for community, celebration, commiseration, communication, and remembrance, TASTEMAKERS showcased the work by Yard-based artist and designer Steph Mantis. Working in close collaboration with restaurateurs at BLDG 77 - Brooklyn Roasting Company, Grandchamps, Jalapa Jar, Russ & Daughters, Transmitter Brewing and Rustik Tavern - Mantis revealed hidden worlds of color and beauty through large-scale digital prints and small-scale sculpture.

TASTEMAKERS ran from May 10, 2018 through November 3, 2018. 1 tenant participated in this show. It was the third exhibit displayed in the gallery space at BLDG 92.
